### **SHOW DETAILS:**

The show will be centered on current Sichuan earthquake disaster. At least 40 posters will be needed with the size of 48”X36”. Presenters need to pay the cost as part of their donation to the event \*. At the close of the show, the exhibited posters will be collected by JCA.

(\* 48” X 36” tri-fold display board is available at the price around \$6 per piece in major stores, such as Target, Wal-Mart, etc. )

### **Display Topics:**

The coverage of this disaster includes, but not limited to, the topics listed below. Presenters are encouraged to come up with their own ideas.

- Impact of the earthquake
  - Images of Pre- and post-earthquake areas :
    - size of earthquake-devastated area equivalent to Europe
    - Visual display of what quake toll of 60,000 people is: ( for example: picture of Alltel Stadium fully seated)
  - ...
- Disaster relief efforts:
  - Condolences extended from world leaders, including President Bush
  - Performances of disaster relief teams in the earthquake zone
  - Donation from big companies and tycoons
  - Hero stories: Ordinary people performing what to them were tiny gestures but ones that made the difference between life and death.
  - Emergency relief to quake-hit Pandas at Wolong Nature Reserve
  - ...
- Personal stories of victims or those who tried to help
  - Grieving and homeless families
  - Suffering of victims
  - Hero stories: Ordinary people who were willing to sacrifice their lives to save others, shielding and protecting the young and weak from harm.
  - ...
- Introduction of the history and culture at the hardest hit areas
  - 184 historic sites damaged or destroyed in the region rich in antiquities
    - History and current situation at Dujiangyan, a vast flood-control system created in 256 B.C. and now a Unesco World Heritage site
    - The Two Kings Temple devastated , a 1,500-year-old Taoist sanctuary perched above Dujiangyan
    - The home of Li Bai shaken apart
    - An 800-year-old wooden pagoda in Jiangyou damaged
  - Jiuzhaigou National Park, a fairy-tale world
  - ...
- Science behind an earthquake:
  - Specifics about how destructive this earthquake was from a scientific standpoint : For example, how Are Earthquake Magnitudes Measured?
  - ...
